LED Interior Lights Conversion

In January, the Library Board approved expenditure of over \$24,000 from the Capital Facility Project account for the conversion of all the current Library interior fluorescent lighting to more efficient LED lighting. Once completed, the project will provide savings for the taxpayers of the Village of North Aurora, realized through lesser need for maintenance and lower operating costs due to the lower energy consumption of the LED lights. The project was completed via a partial grant from Commonwealth Edison. Frost Electrical Company has been working on the project during the Library shutdown and the project will be completed by the end of May.

TumbleBooks has something for everyone: picture books and more on TumbleBookLibrary and TumbleBookMath for Kindergarten-Grade 6, TeenBookCloud for grades 7-12, AudioBookCloud for all ages, and the RomanceBookCloud for adults. The sites are easy to use and feature unlimited access from home!

You can read as many books as you want, when you want, and on any device. There are no check-outs, holds, or downloads. Books are available instantly!


